TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

Ha Nam

- Tam Chuc Pagoda - Considered as the largest temple of the world & one of the most famous Buddhist complexes in Vietnam, with thousands of meticulously assembled stone paintings by skilled craftsmen. Nearly 20 years ago, water conservancy workers discovered that there were many wooden pillars, stone pillars, etc. Some wooden pillars are more than 1 meter in diameter. There is also Tam Chuc Pavilion in the middle of the lake. According to archaeologists' initial, Tam Chuc Pagoda has a history of more than 1,000 years. In 2001, the Prime Minister approved the restoration of Tam Chuc Pagoda. In 2013, Tam Chuc Pagoda was selected as a national tourist area.

Ninh Binh

- The Bai Dinh Pagoda - which has a history of thousands of years, is located in a place near the tourist attraction Ninh Binh. On the beautiful hillside, The Bai Dinh Pagoda is not only huge in size, but also has the largest 13-stories Pagoda in Asia. The Bai Dinh Pagoda enshrines the golden statue of Buddha Sakyamuni. Under the limestone peak to the left of the tower, there are also several dark caves dedicated to fairies hidden, with strange stalactite landscapes and peaceful scenes in the caves. The atmosphere makes visitors feel as if they are in a fairyland. On the hillside is also enshrined a 33-meter-high, 100-ton statue. The largest bronze statue of Bu Dai Monk in Asia, it is said that Bu Dai Monk is the incarnation of Maitreya Buddha, and the image is usually a face with a smile, carrying a cloth bag, it has the meaning of making money and accumulating wealth in harmony, so it is regarded as wealth by the people.

Tam Coc

- Thung Khe Pass - It's a great ideal place to stopover on the way to Moc Chau. From here you will surprise by the beautiful view and visit a small local market to enjoy the grilled eggs, grilled corn, and sticky rice "com lam", it is very attractive.
- The Heart Tea Hill - is known as the heart-shaped green tea plantation or Taiwan Tea Hill. The ant works of farmers makes inspiring source for many couples love to choose as a place to capture wedding photos.
- The Bach Long Bridge - Set as a second Guinness world record as it has the world's longest glass-bottom cliff side path. The glass-floored bridge is the latest tourist attraction in a highlands town well known for its undulating green tea hills and ethnic minority villages.
- Dai Yem Waterfall - one of the best historical landscapes to visit. Falling from the height of 100m, admiring breathtaking view

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
