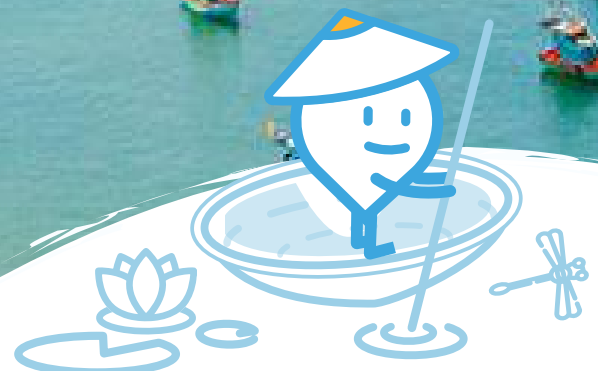

TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

Phu Quoc

- Khu Tuong Pepper Farm - Famous territory for pepper in Phu Quoc.
- Ham Ninh Fishing Village - is an ideal locale for foreign visitors looking to experience the daily life of local fishermen as well as authentic regional dishes at affordable prices. Widely known as one of the oldest villages on Phu Quoc Island, its residents' main sources of income include diving for pearls and sea cucumbers, fishing and, in recent years, selling handmade souvenirs and seafood delicacies to tourist.
- Phu Quoc Prison - Being a prison built by the French colonialist to imprison Vietnamese people which was known as Coconut Tree Prison, in 1967, Saigon Government rebuilt the Coconut Tree Prison into Phu Quoc communist prisoner prison in an area of 400ha, also known as Phu Quoc war prisoner prison, or Phu Quoc prison. This was the largest place to keep communist soldiers in the South with more than 32,000 prisoners.
- Hon Thom Island (Included 2 Way Cable Car) — is a wonderful island to visit. It's the largest and most beautiful island of Hon Thom district of An Thoi archipelago. This island is located in the south of Phu Quoc , is a place to enjoy wild nature even though its infrastructure has been developing rapidly. If you want to take great pictures, the coconut fields and the rock cliffs can provide decent backgrounds. The best thing about Hon Thom is the clean, blue beaches.
- Ho Quoc Pagoda — is the new temple, which was opened in 2012, is located on a high mountain, overlooking the sea. The projects include: Great hero home electrical protection, a group of temples made of wood and stone primitive integrity valuable use of 700-1000 years ... With unspoiled scenery, quiet, Truc Lam Monastery. Explore the Pagoda built by the ancient architecture, with tile, wall tile, high thresholds, wooden door. You will feel all created familiarity, intimacy, and old, whether entirely new buildings.
- VinPearl Land (Include Entrance Ticket) — With a size of 170,000 m2, Phu Quoc Vinpearl Land is invested into the largest and most modern amusement park in Southwest Vietnam, turning Phu Quoc — the beautiful pearl island into the new destination for visitors from all over the country. Besides many attractive indoor and outdoor games and exciting performances, Phu Quoc Vinpearl Land also hosts a series of special events such as Miss Vietnam Final in 2014, Boleros & Love songs 2016 and large seasonal events to meet the needs of customers coming to visit and play. Let's have a closer look at some memorable destinations of Phu Quoc Vinpearl Land.
- Dinh Cau Rock (Cau Temple) — is an odd-shaped natural formation in Phu Quoc Island, which local fishermen pray to before embarking on fishing excursions. Located just next to the Duong Dong Fishing Harbour, it features a brightly-coloured lighthouse and Buddhist shrine, making it a popular photography spot among travellers.
